Olympia Dance Festival 2017

We are participating with other local artists and dance groups in the seventh annual Olympia Dance Festival! We are performing our production, "Get Down To Motown."

Dress Rehearsal: Friday, Feb. 24, 6:20-6:50pm. Please arrive at the Washington Center no later than 5:45 pm, and quickly dress and stretch. We need to be ready if they're running ahead of schedule. For WA Center rehearsals, dancers and families must enter/exit through the backstage door closest to 5th avenue and DO NOT go in the Washington Center lobby as it will not be staffed (parents can cross the "stage right" side to the audience area - please do not walk on the stage marley floor). **Please note:** After this rehearsal, Tumwater Dance Team show dancers can join Andrea & Michelle at Tumwater High School PAC at 8 pm (arrive 7:45) to test music and routines.

10:45-11:45am: FINALE REHEARSAL on stage

- Hip-Hop at Johansen Olympia Dance Center with Sam Picart (winner of Ellen DeGeneres' Dance-Off)
- Flamenco in black box with Marisela Fleites (master teacher/choreographer)
- Jazz at Johansen Olympia Dance Center with Chris Grant-Montoya (former dancer, Les Ballets Trockadero de Monte Carlo)

2:30 pm: Tentative Call Time to be at WA Center, dressed and stretched for show. *Please note: Call Time could be 15-20 min earlier if we find out we perform early in the show.*

3-5 pm: Performance at the WA Center for the Performing Arts

Tickets for this event: \$15.00 (\$12.00 + \$3.00 WA Ctr service fee.) Buy your tickets from Debbi's Dance front desk **through Thurs. Feb. 23** (cash, check or MO to PAAWW, no credit/debit) and support student scholarships. We will hand out pre-purchased tickets at the Friday evening dress rehearsal. Dancers wishing to watch the other performances before and/or after ours will need a ticket. Dancers ages 13 and up may stay in the back stage area during the show. Dancers ages 12 and under will need a chaperone to stay backstage. Olympia Dance Festival staff ask that any performers with tickets to the show, sit in the back of any of the four seating levels so they don't walk in front of other audience members.
